The Northern Valley Crime and Intelligence Analysts Association are pleased to announce its Scholarship Program.

NoVCIAA will award a \$500 scholarship to a qualified individual in their pursuit of continuing education in the area of criminal justice.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- ✚ Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- ✚ At the time of the award, have completed two years of college, or 50 units overall. At least 12 units must be in the area of criminal justice, criminology, or related programs.
- ✚ Be a candidate for a degree at an accredited educational institution (full or part time);
- ✚ Have at least a 3.0 GPA for their college course work.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for award of the NoVCIAA Scholarship, the following documentation must be submitted:

- ✚ A one to two page essay describing your personal, educational, and career goals;
- ✚ All related official school transcripts, including current enrollment status and number of units;
- ✚ Two recent letters of recommendation: one personal and one professional, from an employer or an individual who has evaluated you in an academic setting;
- ✚ A copy of a recent statement of earnings.

The completed application packet must be **received** no later than June 30 of the current year. The award will be announced by July 31 of each year.
